

## Fraser Valley Stage COVID 19 Protocols – Website Information for Patrons

FVS in conjunction with the Abbotsford Arts Centre will be following all British Columbia Public Health COVID 19 protocols.

- Stay at home if you are sick. For COVID 19 symptoms refer to:

- Picture identification and proof of vaccination will be required via the BC Vaccination Passport (digital or paper facsimile) for entry to each performance. To attend a performance, you must have received two doses of the COVID 19 vaccine.
- Upon entrance to the venue your name and contact details will be recorded for the purpose of contact tracing.
- Non-medical masks must be worn.
- Entrance and exits to and from the building will be controlled and staggered to prevent overcrowding.
- Hands are to be sanitized upon entry to the building – hand sanitizing stations will be in all high traffic areas.
- Seating will be arranged in groups of 2 / 4/ 6 with social distancing in mind; ushers will assign you seats; no changing of seats once seated.
- Refrain from walking around the venue unless to washroom or to concession/bar area.
- Pre-order of alcoholic drinks will be available for intermission.
- Number of patrons in the washroom at a time will be limited.
- Cleaning & sanitization will be carried out on a regular basis as per Public Health recommendations.

**\*\* If a situation arises that the performances are cancelled as a result of Public Health Orders, ticket purchases will be fully refunded \*\***
